What is the best part of your job?

My career is a blessing, and, as any fellow industry professional will agree, we are helping people achieve the best version of themselves so that they can feel externally what they feel internally. Most of my patients are energized, have active careers, are family driven and feel healthy on the inside, but the natural physical aging process doesn't mesh with their inner feeling. Today, aesthetic medicine is exciting because we have a multitude of modalities to treat and slow down aging without surgery and invasive procedures. Bio-regenerative medicine is a raging field and very much a part of people's treatments in Europe and Asia, and I am both proud and excited to bring new bioregenerative methods to Atlanta.

What is the ethos behind

Some key aspects of the ethos in my practice include upholding the highest ethical standards. I strive to always provide my patients with patient-centered care, listening to their concerns, understanding their goals and tailoring treatments to meet their unique needs. Patient safety, comfort and informed decision-making are paramount.

What do you think sets you apart from your competition?

I have over twelve years of experience in the practice of aesthetic medicine and am an active educator and trainer for nonsurgical cosmetic procedures throughout the United States. I teach other physicians, dentists and healthcare professionals about the art of injectables, including botulinum toxin and dermal filler injections. My practice is also one of the first aesthetic practices in the Atlanta area experienced in bio-regenerative medicine and relies on new-age bioregeneration to holistically approach patients' aging process rather than bandaging the aging process. Through bio-rejuvenation, we can stimulate

collagen growth and regenerative cells leading to skin repair and regeneration of collagen. This is an exciting new field of aesthetic medicine, and I'm proud to be one of the first practices to bring this aspect of aesthetics to this city.

What are the positive ways you use your power in your community?

My business partner and husband, Dr. Abtin Shahriari of Greater Atlanta Oral Facial Surgery, and I are proud to have sponsored and continue to sponsor several key community organizations through financial support and spending time volunteering. We annually sponsor The Pink Agenda and Prevent Blindness Georgia, which has personal meaning to our family and recently sponsored An Evening for Education with Odyssey Atlanta, a summer program offering free of cost education to motivated Atlanta public school students in rising grades 1 through 12 from underserved communities to help motivate and instill lifelong learning. We also love having our boots on the ground with community service projects, including collecting food items for local homeless shelters such as My Sister's House and assisting with park cleanups in our neighborhoods. It is very important to our family to involve our children in continually assessing how we can serve our local communities. Success is not reaped when people stand alone; rather, it is cultivated by working to make your community thrive.

What is the most valuable thing you've learned about your career? Successful careers are built through

hard work and perseverance. I am proud that my skills as an aesthetic physician are a reflection of years of dedication, self-guided continued learning and a desire to set limitless career goals for myself.

What first sparked your interest in medicine, health and wellness and drew you to your specialty?

I became interested in medicine when I first started working with the WHO and CDC after completing my Masters's degree in Public Health, working to eradicate polio in remote places such as Bihar, India. My volunteer work in Songea, East Africa helped me decide to choose oral maxillofacial surgery as a field to pursue as my speciality- I was driven toward the field of surgery because I knew it could have a tangible and immediate impact on the lives of my patients while allowing me the opportunity to harness creativity through problemsolving. The complexity of oral maxillofacial surgery, as well as the interdisciplinary nature of the field, which includes surgery, anesthesia and patient-centered care, as well as the technical and creative skills characteristic of this discipline, all drew me to this particular field.

What about your work continues to inspire you today?

I'm inspired by modern technology. Modern technology has the ability to dramatically optimize my patient's surgical outcomes. It also motivates me to evolve with the latest surgical technology, refining and improving precision through minimally invasive surgical techniques. We are the first dental practice in the southeast to use Facial iD technology for custom-designed dental implants engineered for patients with unique jaw architecture and for complex corrective jaw surgeries. We are also the only dental practice in the U.S. to have performed the first case of placing mandibular dental implants into patients who would have otherwise failed dental implant procedures. My practice is also the 35th surgical center in the world to perform the guided zygomatic implant placement procedure. We are proud of this history of

accomplishments in cutting-edge dental implant technologies and will continue to break boundaries in bringing the latest dental technologies to the Southeast.

What drew you to practice in Atlanta, and how has that decision been rewarding?

I am a native Atlantan and continued my education at Emory after finishing dental school at the University of Pennsylvania. I knew I wanted to start a family in Atlanta and watch the city prosper, and be a part of Atlanta's continued growth.

What is the best advice you've ever received?

The best advice is from my father, who always taught me to never give up and to continually strive to learn.

What is up next for you in terms of your career and your practice, clinical trials or any news we can spotlight?

I am proud to share that my practice is one of the first to use bioregenerative techniques to improve surgical outcomes. I also strive to learn new techniques in dental implant surgery and teach worldwide.

Is there anything else you'd like to add or think we should know about you?

It is an honor to be chosen by my peers as one of the Top Dentists of 2023, and I'm humbled by the peer-based recognition of my surgical skills. I am proud to be the Chief Surgical Director of two state-of-the art surgical centers, which are the only two oral surgery offices certified by the Accreditation Association of Ambulatory Health Care (AAAHC) in the entire state of Georgia.

AAAHC certification makes my office stand out in the Atlanta area as one committed and focused on patients' safety.
